

# Content Tags (August 2008)

## mamboSchools Content Tag Examples

When accessing the content component and others which use the content editor, you can add tags to create tabs and slides, link to Wikipedia, add video and make simple image galleries.



### Adding Tabs:

```
{tab=tabname01}
```

Type text below each tab. You can add images, links, and text formatting.

```
{tab=tabname02}
```

Type text below each tab. You can add images, links, and text formatting.

```
{tab=tabname03}
```

Type text below each tab. You can add images, links, and text formatting.

```
{/tabs}
```

### Adding Slides:

```
{slide=slidetitle01}
```

Type text in paragraph form or in a list below each slide. You can add images, links, and text formatting. You must close each slide.

```
{/slide}
```

```
{slide=slidetitle02}
```

Type text in paragraph form or in a list below each slide. You can add images, links, and text formatting. You must close each slide.

```
{/slide}
```

### Linking to Wikipedia:

When typing a sentence about `[[John Kennedy]]`, notice the double brackets around the words above. Placing double brackets around words will create a direct link to Wikipedia.

NOTE: You may want to check that your term will directly link to a Wikipedia article. Use the Wikipedia site and the search box (located in the left column) to verify.

### Embedding a YouTube Video:

```
{youtube}youtube_URL_code{/youtube}
```

Example: `{youtube} oQOu0IAdgaA{/youtube}`. This example displays President Kennedy's "To the Moon" speech.

NOTE: You will have to search YouTube for your video and copy the code at the end of the URL.

### Embedding an mp3 Audio File:

```
{audio}directory_path/filename.mp3{/audio}
```

Example:

```
{audio}images/stories/audio/pilot.mp3{/audio}
```

NOTE: You must transfer your mp3 audio file to the *audio* directory nested inside of the *stories* directory.

### Creating a Content Photo Gallery:

```
{gallery}directory_pathname{/gallery}
```

Example:

```
{gallery}dave_images{/gallery}
```

NOTE: Using the image editor button, create a directory and upload photos inside this directory.
